

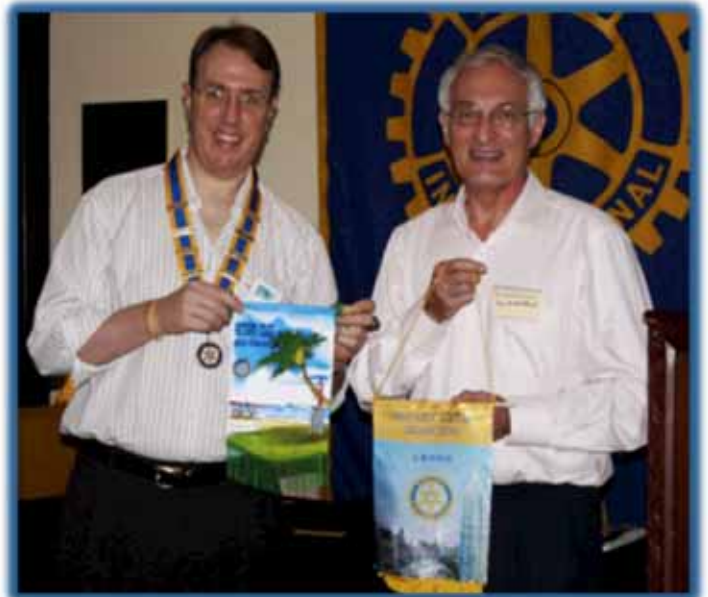


- **President Patricia:**

GUEST SPEAKER

Our very own [Rtn. Muriel](#) introduced her topic by comparing 'Mother Nature' and 'Mother Earth' literally to the example of a human mother and how we usually refer to our mothers with respect,



gratitude and care. However, mankind seems to not see this connection to the environment with **our destructive and disrespectful attitude** and actions towards the planet earth, which has been like a Mother to mankind for millenniums.

Rtn. Muriel referred to the example of **plastic bags in Bali** where **10 million plastic bags are used per day**, which costs **Rp. 20 per bag**, equaling **Rp. 200 million worth of bags that are eventually disposed of and in a TOXIC manner (burned, dumped into a landfill / ocean / mangrove) !!!**

Rtn. Muriel then presented a short film entitled 'THE STORY OF STUFF.' This easy to understand film narrated a diagram of the emergence of consumer goods through its history until its disposal.

A. Extraction of Resources

1. Already one third of the planet's natural resources have been used up by man/woman.
2. In the USA, only 4% of the original forests remain.
3. The USA has 5% of the world's population and creates 30% of the world's waste.
4. 75% of the fisheries are extinct.
5. 85% of the forests are extinct.

B. Means of Production

1. Many products produced used toxic materials.
2. Breast milk of mothers today has high doses of toxins.
3. Factory workers are exposed to 4 billion lbs. of toxic materials every year.

C. Distribution

1. Social pressures to keep materials moving in the cycle of production and distribution.
2. Child labor - 30% of the children in the Congo work in factories

D. Golden Arrow of Consumption

1. Planned obsolescence: intentionally producing products that will require replacing, breakdown and disposal after a period of time.
2. Media control of mind-set to encourage consumption beyond needs..

E. Disposal

1. 4.5 lbs. of garbage is produced by each individual per day.
2. This is commonly disposed causing pollution to land, air or water.
3. Dioxin which is the most toxic manmade substance is the result of burning garbage.
4. Much garbage is not recyclable.

Points of Intervention: RENEWABLE ENERGY.
