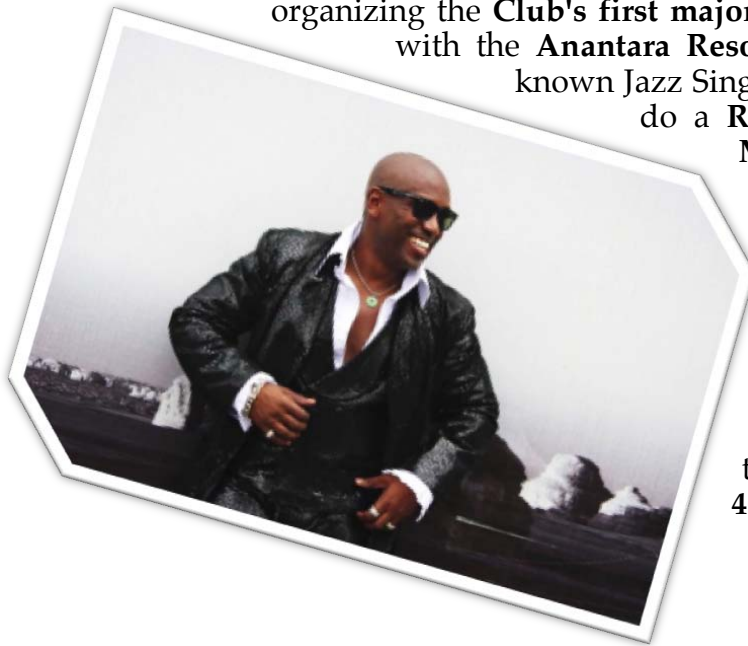
The Day's activities will include:

## 'What's Rotary' by IPP Urs Klee

**IPP Urs**, for the benefit of our MEDIA Guests, briefly outlined the philosophy and benefits of being a member of Rotary International.



He started by answering the question 'What's Rotary?'

*"Rotary is a worldwide organization of more than 1.2 million business, professional, and community leaders. Members of Rotary clubs, known as Rotarians, provide humanitarian service encourage high ethical standards in service, all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world."*

*"There are 33,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas. Clubs are nonpolitical, nonreligious and open to all cultures, races and creeds. As signified by the motto 'Service Above Self,' Rotary's main objective is service — in the community, in the workplace, and throughout the world."*

Next, IPP Urs talked about the History, the famous 'Four-Way Test,' The Rotary Foundation, and the many programs it supports, i. e.

- Ambassadorial Scholarships
- Group Study Exchange
- Project Grants (Global and District)
- PolioPlus
- Peace and Conflict studies

IPP Urs then moved on and gave some specific details about our Rotary Club.

1. The RCBS was chartered on 14 May 2002 and consists primarily of expatriates living in the Kuta area.
2. The RCBS is the ONLY English-speaking Club in the Kuta area (Tuban / Legian / Seminyak / Kerobokan).
3. The RCBS meets every Wednesday from 12:30 to 14:00 (12:00 fellowship) at the Sofitel Hotel Seminyak.
4. The RCBS has a 'special' Fellowship evening every Thursday from 17:30 - 19:00 at the Anantara Seminyak.
