

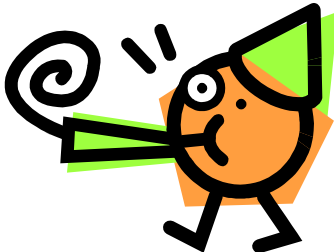

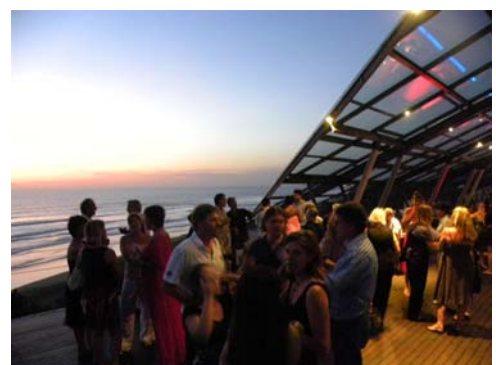

- **Robert E.** took a minute and enthusiastically told the members about the upcoming **Bali Clean Up Day**:

Proposal is for Bali Clean Up Day to take place either on **13 or 19 Sept. 2010**, to coincide with a **global initiative same day**, and to be repeated every year. Throughout the year training will take place at as many schools and selected banjar as possible every month. The following organizations will be involved; **ECO- Bali , BHA, BTDC , and BIWA**, who have agreed to be PR and contact the Govt as well as our own **Rtn. Made Ariawan**.

Only part the rubbish on the beaches is stuff being washed over from Lombok. Mainly it's coming from the rivers and people dumping their personal stuff on the beaches and everywhere. Particularly in rainy season this rubbish washes down to the river and on to the beach. Many hotels rubbish is dumped by trucks only at the Mangrove which at high tide is swept away to the ocean.. than back to our beaches again.



RC of Bali Nusa Dua have agreed to facilitate and donate **Rp. 20,000,000** to rent trucks and to buy waste tanks. The total project cost is estimated to be **Rp 215,000,000**. It was proposed that **RC of Bali Nusa Dua, RC of Bali Sanur, RC of Bali Taman and RCBS** work jointly together to raise funds for a big truck (**around \$37k**). **Rtn. Nunie (RC of Bali Nusa Dua)** felt that this was something the **Bill Gates Foundation** may be interested in doing!



For this whole thing to be sustainable it will very much need people to be re-educated and a big change in attitude and an ongoing high profile campaign to spread awareness. **GUS Foundation** have organised for over **100 schools** to collect rubbish and between 10-15 have their own tanks and re-cycling facilities, they are also training youth in collaboration with the **Ministry of Education**.

Rtn. Nunie will bring with her - when she presents to **RCBS 7 July** - one of the decomposition boxes, which turns all organic foodstuffs into liquid within a week - to be used on plants and the garden.

Peduli Alam (Protect Nature) by Charlotte Fredouille



Rtn. Raphaël Devianne introduced the Club's Guest Speaker, Ms **Charlotte Fredouille**. After studying communication and cultural integration for six years in France, she worked for **Yves Saint Laurent in Paris** for three years. During this working experience, the Saint Laurent team encouraged her to join a French NGO working in Nepal. She worked with them for one year before joining the **Yayasan Anak (Children's Foundation) in Bali** in January 2008.

After only living and working in Bali for one year, she was shocked at the environmental situation here and decided to start her own NGO - **Peduli Alam** whose primary GOAL is to **protect the environment in Bali against non-organic household waste**.

Charlotte started her talk by explaining to the members WHY she thought it was necessary to form the **Yayasan Peduli Alam**.

- The proper disposal / management of non-organic garbage is a big problem in Bali.
- Many Community Members do not understand the negative consequences of non-organic garbage.
- In many rural areas of Bali, there are no governmental waste collection systems for non-organic garbage.



To begin to solve this very serious problem in Amed, Karangasem, East Bali, Peduli Alam has started to:

- Organize educational-awareness campaigns in elementary schools.
- Build private, public, small business, and school garbage bins.
- Organize garbage collections once a week.

Charlotte concluded her brief talk by outlining **Peduli Alam's** current needs:

- Funds to buy materials to build and maintain the garbage bins in Amed.
- Funds to buy materials to build and maintain garbage bins in other parts of Bali.
- Funds to buy a small truck to collect garbage from villages in the mountains where larger trucks cannot go.
- Funds to buy educational materials to teach in elementary schools.
- Funds to pay for an office and the salary of an Indonesian Project Manager.

After answering a few questions, Charlotte said she hoped that the RCBS would be interested in helping **Peduli Alam** reach its important short-term GOALS .
