Already the first batch of 10 students have successfully graduated from high school and one student is applying for continuing education at a college in Ubud under the continued sponsorship of the Rotary Club of Bali, Seminyak. As a result of the success of this project, it is now being expanded to 20 high school students this year in order to give more youngsters from Nusa Penida the chance of a good education and the ability to find a good job in the future. This will of course also benefit the future development of both Nusa Penida and Bali. The continued success of this ongoing project therefore depends on your kind support.
