Topic: Cost-Free Rehabilitation for the Women of Bali

- Bali Women's Lighthouse is the first free recovery home exclusive to Indonesian women, providing them with an opportunity to get sober and create a new life for themselves and their families. It provides medical care, psychiatric care, infant and child care, HIV/AIDS treatment, harm reduction education, job training, job placement, and transitional housing following incarceration. The 90-day program provides rehabilitation from the disease of addiction. Rtn. Shawna explained the aspects of addiction and methods of prevention of alcohol and drug abuse disorders. The proposal for a project costs Rp. 9,463,888 per month. The total cost is Rp. 23,391,667 for 90-day

treatment to feed, house, and care for one woman completing the program.
