HM Mary proceeded to present the Smile Foundation (Yayasan Senyum) Annual Report with their vision to reduce the suffering currently associated with craniofacial abnormalities and performing cleft lip palate operations. The mission of

SMILE is to improve the quality of life for facilitating the delivery of health care to people with craniofacial disabilities in Indonesia in partnership with local and international health care professionals and others working to support lower income families.

This past year there has been a visit from the Benjamin Foundation and the Minister of Finance. There has been nursing training with Smile Train Training. Although the numbers of operations have been lowered this past year due to the COVID pandemic, the history of SMILE from 2006 has been very successful. There are also 3 Smile Shops, 2 in Sanur and one in Nyuh Kuning, which contains item donations for sale to support the Foundation. IN Dec., 2020, there was an audit for Smile, which comprises the income and expenditures and related statements of activities, for the year ended.

RCBS for many years has supported Mary's outstanding work in the community and will continue to do so for such a good cause.
